

**LESSON: Show the Class PowerPoint/
Slide Show to an Audience**

Grade Level: K

OBJECTIVES:

Students will:

- Reinforce what they learned in the lesson about the artist, Andy Goldsworthy
- Show the slide show of their nature sculptures to others

MATERIALS:

Computer and projector, PowerPoint, keynote presentation, or slideshow made from student photos & slide projector

PRESENTATION:

Explain that the class will be showing their nature sculpture PowerPoint presentation or slide show to another class, PTA, or group of parents. This presentation is the nature sculptures which they made in the lesson on Andy Goldsworthy; *Collaboration with Nature & Math*

Directions:

1. Talk with the students about who they would like to show their presentation to—school faculty and administrators, another classroom, a group of parents.
2. If other classes are making slide shows or creating puppet shows or plays, explore the idea of putting together a show including all of the class projects.
3. Schedule the presentation and show the presentation.
4. Form a circle with the students and ask questions like these—
 - What happened as we developed our slide show?
 - Are there things you would do differently now that you've done it once?
 - How do you feel about the show we just put on?
 - What did you learn?
 - What did you like best?
 - Did you get any new ideas from the show we just presented (and watched)?
 - What can our class do to follow up this show?
